## Who does PCR Serve?

- Providence Cristo Rey High School (PCRHS) serves students with demonstrated economic needs who otherwise could not afford a college preparatory education.
- Our current demographics:
  - 100% Qualify for Federal Free and Reduced Lunch
  - 100% Receive Financial Aid to attend PCRHS
  - 96% of PCR students are people of color.

## What challenges do PCRHS students face?

PCR students face specific challenges around:

- Basic needs like housing, transportation, food, and clothing
- Access: College preparatory educational programs and financial aid.
- Opportunities for success: Networking and professional skills.

## How do we measure our success?

We measure our results by the performance of our scholars upon completion of high school and life beyond. Knowing that an education is the foundation for a better life.

- 100% college acceptance rate for every graduating class
- Seniors graduate with an average of 17 college credits
- 100% of PCR students work one day per week. It is our goal to have 100% of those jobs paid or funded. We are currently at 94% for the 2024-25 school year.
